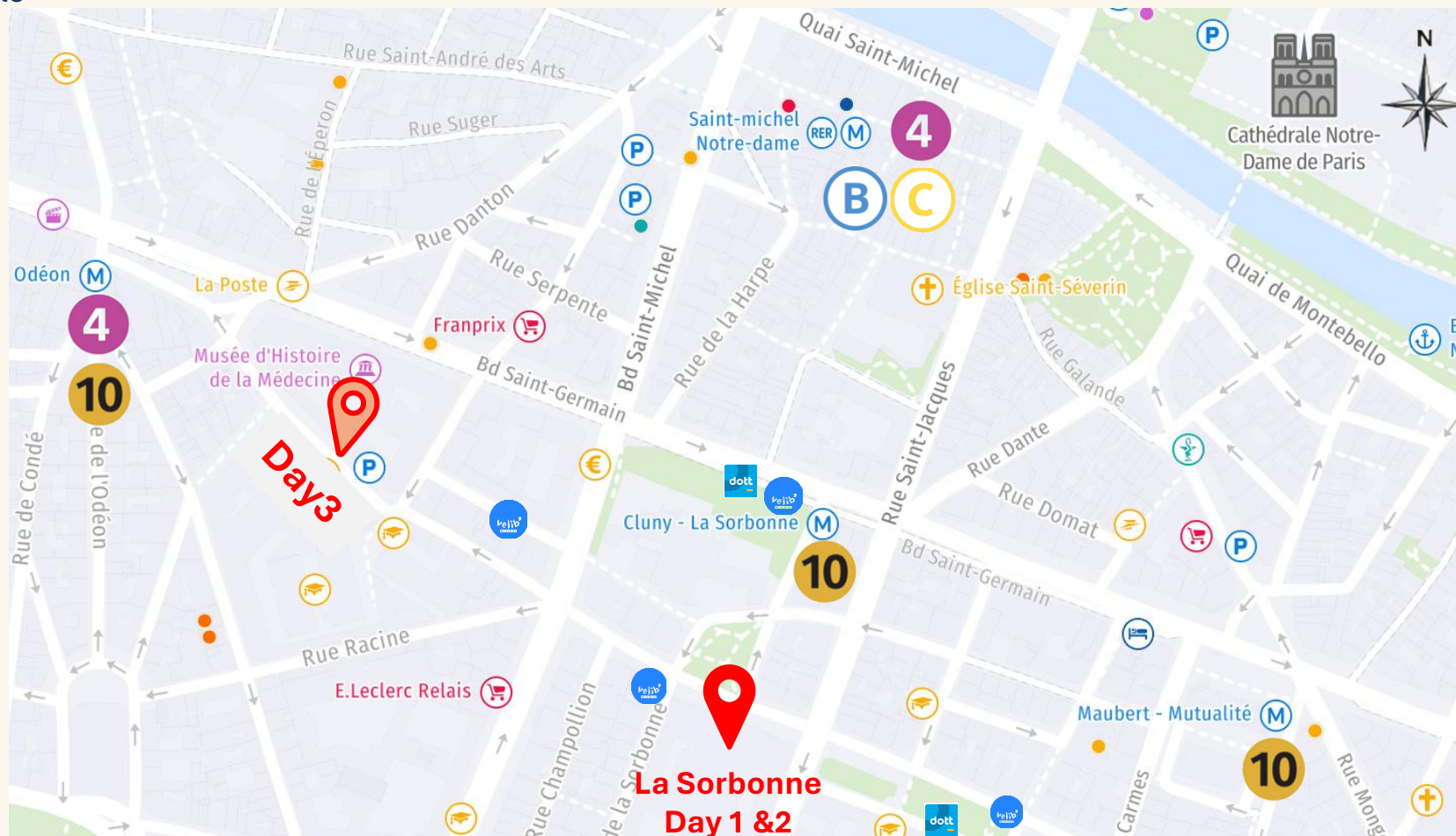

Transportation Guide



Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG)
RER B → Saint-Michel–Notre-Dame (≈ 40 min)
Taxi: fixed fare to Paris Left Bank (≈65€)



Orly Airport (ORY)
Metro Line 14 + Line 10 or RER B
Taxi: fixed fare to Paris Left Bank (≈36€)



Useful information

- The metro and bicycles are the fastest ways to get around, but buses are sometimes less crowded.
- When boarding a bus, enter through the front door. Tickets can be purchased from ticket machines or by SMS.
- Public transport is open from 5:30 a.m. – 1:15 a.m. & rush hours are typically 8:00–9:00 a.m. and 5:00–6:30 p.m.

Keep your phone, wallet, and passport in secure, closed pockets or bags, preferably in front of you.

Be aware of pickpockets, especially in busy streets and on public transportation

Journeys to and from Paris airports require a specific airport fare and are not covered by standard metro tickets.

Useful information

- Most **museums** are closed on Mondays
Please check opening hours before visiting.
- **Shops** are usually open 10 am- 8pm
- **Tipping** is not mandatory but appreciated in restaurant (1 – 2 euros)
- **Electricity** (Voltage: 230V - Plug types: C and E)
- **Money** : Euro (€); Credit cards & Contactless payment are widely accepted (American Express may not be accepted everywhere)

Eiffel Tower Iconic iron tower built for the 1889 World's Fair.	
Louvre Museum World-renowned art museum, home to the Mona Lisa.	
Notre-Dame Cathedral Gothic masterpiece on the Île de la Cité.	
Musée d'Orsay Impressionist art museum in a former Beaux-Arts railway station.	
Arc de Triomphe Monument honoring those who fought and died for France.	
Champs-Élysées Famous avenue for shopping, dining and walks.	
Sacré-Cœur Basilica White basilica on top of Montmartre hill offering stunning views.	
Opéra Garnier Magnificent opera house built in the 19th century.	
Luxembourg Gardens Beautiful public garden perfect for a relaxing break.	
Panthéon Neoclassical monument housing France's great figures.	
Place de la Concorde Historic square with the Luxor Obelisk.	
Moulin Rouge Famous cabaret in the heart of Montmartre.	
Pont Alexandre III Ornate bridge with breathtaking views.	
Invalides Historic complex home to Napoleon's tomb.
